“When I Grow Up”

Location:

All Rehearsals on **June 23rd, 24th and 25th** and Recitals on **June 27th and 28th**
will be held at the studio 802 Dacula Rd Dacula 30019

In Studio Rehearsal:

The purpose of this rehearsal is to make dancers feel more comfortable for their recital day. Your dancer should wear regular dance clothes (not costume) and dance shoes to this rehearsal. Please have your dancer arrive at the studio **15 minutes before your scheduled rehearsal time**. Because of the strict schedule, we will not be able to delay starting a class's rehearsal to wait for students. If your dancer misses their class's assigned time, they may miss their chance to practice. Each group will practice 2-3 times. If your dancer's class has 2 dances, they will practice both dances back to back. Rehearsal will be drop off only, as required for safe social distancing. Details and an instructional video with specific drop off and pick up instructions will be sent out the week of June 15th. We will be following our new guidelines including taking dancers temperatures and hand sanitizing upon entering the building for rehearsal.

Recital Day:

We wish that we were able to have our traditional recital in a theater and look forward to when we are able to do so again. With local theaters not renting, the state limiting numbers for gatherings, and the need to monitor cleaning procedures we have decided to have our recitals at the studio. We are setting up a performance area to make this a very special day for all of our dance families, and to recreate as much of the experience of recital as possible. In order to follow current guidelines for social distancing, dancers will be strictly limited to 2 guests on performance day. However, we will be streaming the show live for your family and friends to watch from the safety of their home. You will also receive a digital recording of all recital dances as normally included in your recital fees. Details and an instructional video with specific recital-day instructions will be sent out the week of June 15th. We will be asking all dancers and guests to follow new guidelines including taking the dancers temperatures at check in and all dancers and guests must sanitize their hands. Masks are optional for dancers and guests, as all dancers and attendees will be placed to maintain social distancing.

Flowers:

Giving flowers to dancers is a custom that has existed for hundreds of years. For your convenience we will be selling bouquets for you to give your dancer at the show. These bouquets are always beautiful and sourced from a local florist... Design House of Flowers. Bouquets are \$12 and must be pre ordered by June 20th.

Hair:

Please see the paper attached to your costume garment bag for your dancer's show day hair style. We encourage you to use hair spray and gel to make your dancers hair look neat and to keep any wispy hairs away. If you have any questions about the hairstyle for your dancer's class, please let us know.

Stage Make-Up:

We encourage dancers to wear red lipstick, blush, brown eyeshadow, and mascara for their performance.

Recital Pictures:

Join **Captured By Kassie Photography** in the downstairs studio immediately following your dancer's performance on Sat/Sun for optional pictures. No group photos will take place this year, only individual photos. An order form will be available soon on our website.
