What is a Competitive Dance Company?

Competitive dance is for the dancer who wants to become more involved in dance and take his/her dance training to the next level. As a competitive dancer, one will receive advanced technical training that is designed to challenge and inspire him or her to grow both as a dancer and as a person. At GDU, we believe competitive dance also teaches important life lessons including teamwork, self confidence, dedication, and perseverance.

GDU Star Company is a serious commitment. Once you have committed to our company you must remember that we require you to make us your FIRST COMMITMENT. Classes, rehearsals, and performances must take precedence over all other extra-curricular activities.

What are dance competitions?

Dance competitions are events where dance studios in an area (usually the state) come together to compete against each other with pre-choreographed dance routines. Competition categories are generally grouped by dance style, group size, and age of competitor(s). A panel of professional judges will score the dance, and provide comments and critiques. Winners receive awards, prizes, and chances to compete at higher-level competition (National Championships).

Additional Information:

We will have a parent meeting in August to go over details for the rest of the year including the Competition schedule.

All dancers will compete in 4 dance competitions (2 out of state) during the spring and perform in our annual spring recital.

Hip Hop, Shooting Teen, Rising and Shining Star Companies will come two Saturdays a month.

Mini and Shooting Jr. Stars will come one Saturday a month during the months of September, October, November, January, and February. One additional rehearsal may be required for March and for April. We will also have a mock competition one Saturday in either January or February (date TBD). We will announce all Saturdays for the entire year as soon as we receive the competition schedule so that you can mark those dates on your calendars.

We require all company parents to volunteer a minimum of three times during the year for events such as helping with our Saturday dinners, prop building, costuming, charity events, etc. A form will be available at our Parent Meeting in August.

Solo Requirements

Solos will not be guaranteed to every dancer that wants one. Solos cost a great amount of time and money. A solo requires the dancer to learn quickly and practice independently. Therefore, this year we feel the need to place stricter stipulations onto dancers that qualify for a solo. This season we will be examining the following.

1. Dancer's work ethic: First we expect 110% effort in rehearsing their group dances. Group dances are and will always be our primary focus.
2. Dancer's commitment to practicing independently at home each day, listening to their music, and completing the weekly practice log.
3. Dancer's classroom behavior and effort.
4. Dancer's must exhibit their ability to listen to corrections from their choreographers, other GDU teachers, and judges and apply those corrections.
5. Dancer's must be able to demonstrate skills and techniques applicable to both their age and competition levels.

Please note, we do not want to discourage anyone desiring to perform a solo, but we also have noticed a need for better quality control. This may sound harsh, but please know this comes from a place of respect for our choreographers' talents, our dancers' passions, and our parents' budgets.
