DRESS CODE

It is very important that dancers are prepared for dance class each week. This includes the correct clothing, shoes, hair pulled up away from face and any other accessories needed like a dance bag for our younger students to keep their shoes in. Please don't forget to write your dancer's name on their shoes.

Tiny Ballerina and Tiny Dancers Age 2

This class is designed for the youngest dancer to become accustomed to the structure of dance class while having the comfort of a parent present. The goal at the end of the year is for the dancer to have learned basic skills and be confident in a class without their parent.

Dress code: Pink leather ballet shoes, pink tights, any color leotard or ballet dress. Hair pulled out of face. Parents for Tiny Ballerina/Dancer class please wear comfortable clothes.

Tutus, Tap and Tumbling Ages 3-5

This fun and energetic class introduces dancers to the basics of ballet and tap. Your child will twirl like a ballerina and shuffle to the beat, building rhythm, coordination, and confidence along the way. Perfect for dancers who love graceful moves and upbeat music—it's a magical mix of elegance and excitement!

Dress code: Pink leather ballet shoes, tan tap shoes, and any color/style leotard or dance dress. Skirt and tights are optional. Hair pulled out of face. Dance bag for shoes.

Fairytale Ballet Ages 3-5

Our Fairy Tale Ballet class is designed to spark your child's imagination while introducing the basics of ballet. Each week features a fun, themed adventure—whether it's dancing like a princess, twirling through an enchanted forest, or leaping with fairies. With a focus on creativity, movement, and storytelling, this class keeps little dancers engaged and excited to learn every step of the way.

Dress code: Pink leather ballet shoes, pink tights, any color leotard or ballet dress. Hair pulled out of face.

Kindertastic and Ballet/Tap/Jazz Combo: Ages 5-10

This fun combo class is the perfect introduction to the world of dance! Dancers will explore the elegance of ballet, the rhythm of tap, and the upbeat energy of jazz—all in one fun-filled class. Each style encourages creativity, coordination, and confidence. With music, movement, and lots of smiles, this class keeps young dancers engaged while building a solid foundation across three dance styles!

Dress code: Pink leather ballet shoes, tan tap shoes, and any color/style leotard or dance dress. Skirt and tights are optional. Hair pulled out of face. Dance bag for shoes.

Ballet Ages 6+

Dancers will develop their ballet technique, posture, and flexibility while learning barre work, center combinations, and choreography. A great class for building discipline, grace, and confidence.

Dress Code: Pink leather ballet shoes, pink tights, Ballet 1 light blue or black leotard, Company ballet black leotard. Hair must be secured in a bun. Skirt is optional.

Tap Ages 3+

This class focuses on building strong tap technique and rhythm skills through fun combinations and choreography. Perfect for dancers who love to move, make noise, and challenge their musicality!

Dress Code: Fitted jazz shorts or leggings and leotard or a fitted cami/tank top. No baggy tshirt or pants. Tan tap shoes. Hair pulled out of face.

Jazz Ages 6+

Jazz dance is an upbeat and energetic class, using current age appropriate music. Designed to develop strength, body placement, coordination, musicality and performance style. Focusing on proper terminology and technique. Through warm-up, across the floor and combinations, dancers will learn the best and newest jazz movements and steps. Leaps, turns and other jazz moves will be taught.

Dress Code: Fitted jazz shorts or leggings and leotard or a fitted cami/tank top. No baggy tshirt or pants. Tan jazz shoes.

Musical Theater 6+

For the star who loves to sing, dance, and shine on stage!

This Musical Theater class is perfect for young performers who dream of the spotlight. Combining dance, acting, and a touch of singing, dancers will bring Broadway-style routines to life through storytelling and character work. Each class builds confidence, stage presence, and expression as students learn fun choreography inspired by popular musicals. of face.

Dress Code: Fitted jazz shorts or leggings and leotard or a fitted cami/tank top. No baggy tshirt or pants. Tan tap shoes. Hair pulled out of face.

Tumbling 6+

This class is great for building strength, flexibility, and confidence while learning basic tumbling skills. Dancers will work on rolls, cartwheels, handstands, walkovers, handsprings, and more.

Dress Code: Fitted jazz shorts or leggings and leotard or a fitted cami/tank top. Hair pulled out of face. No shoes needed

Hip Hop Ages 3+

This high-energy class lets dancers move with freedom and confidence while expressing their own unique style! Inspired by today's hottest music and dance trends, our Hip Hop classes focus on fun, rhythm, and self-expression. All music and movement are age-appropriate, creating a safe and upbeat environment for dancers to grow and groove.

Dress Code: Comfortable clothes you can move in (no jeans) and sneakers.
